What is friendship and twinning?

- Friendship and twinning links with Palestine are connections between people, set up to exchange experiences, share culture, develop friendships and express solidarity
- It's an important way to show support, engage with, listen to, and learn from people who are affected by the Israeli occupation, and to find out how to help change things
- Connections are often place based, or based on a shared interest, religious beliefs or links between arts, sports and educational groups

What is the BPFTN?

- A network of around 40 individual groups of all shapes and sizes, all with a common aim; to build friendship links with people in Palestine.
- The network promotes twinning and friendship between a range of different communities and groups, supports its members with their work, and new groups to establish themselves.

- show your support, solidarity and appreciation of Palestinian people and their culture
- take part in a two way learning, sharing and exchange process between people
- focus on human connections and building friendships between people from all walks of life
